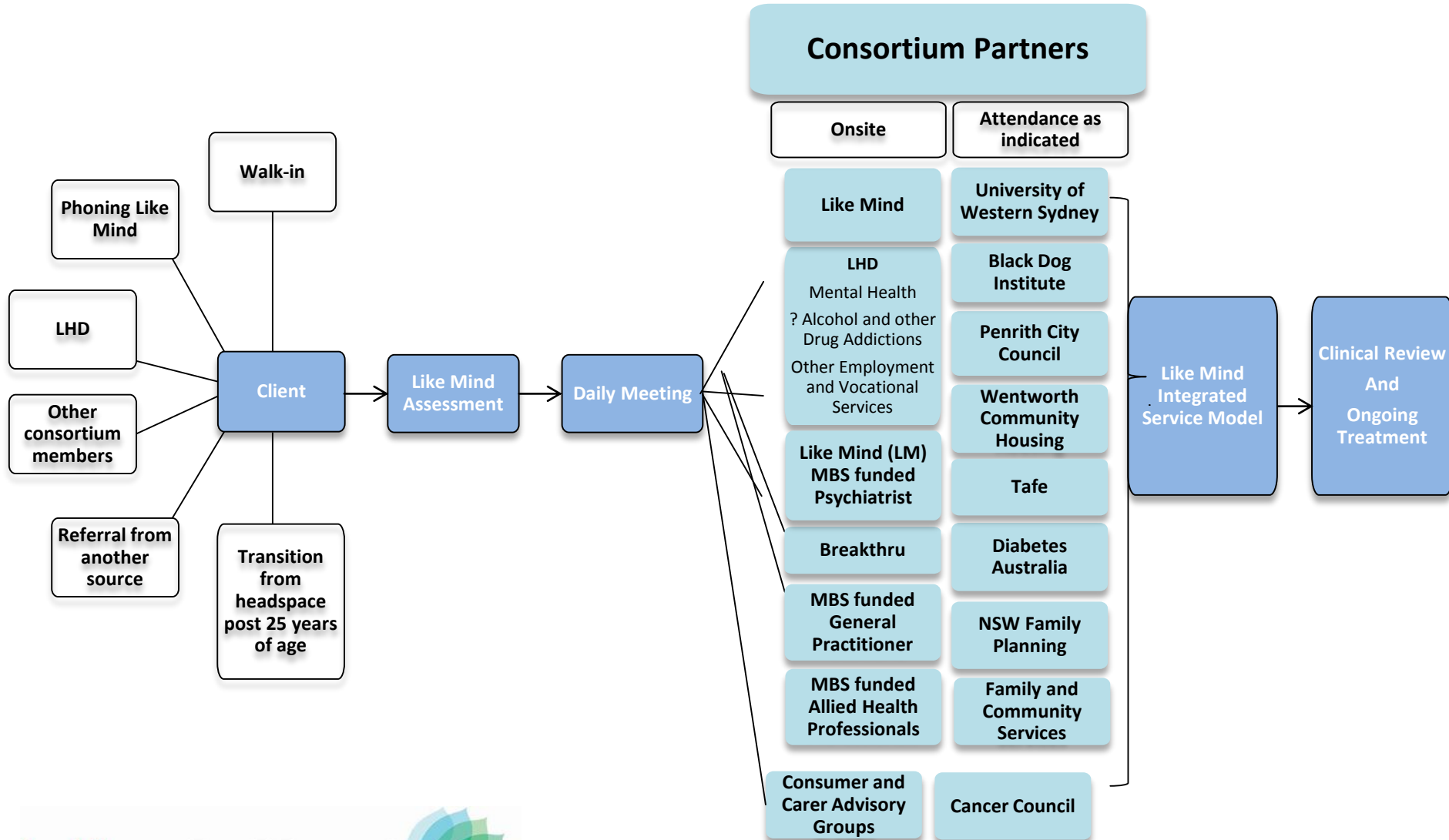

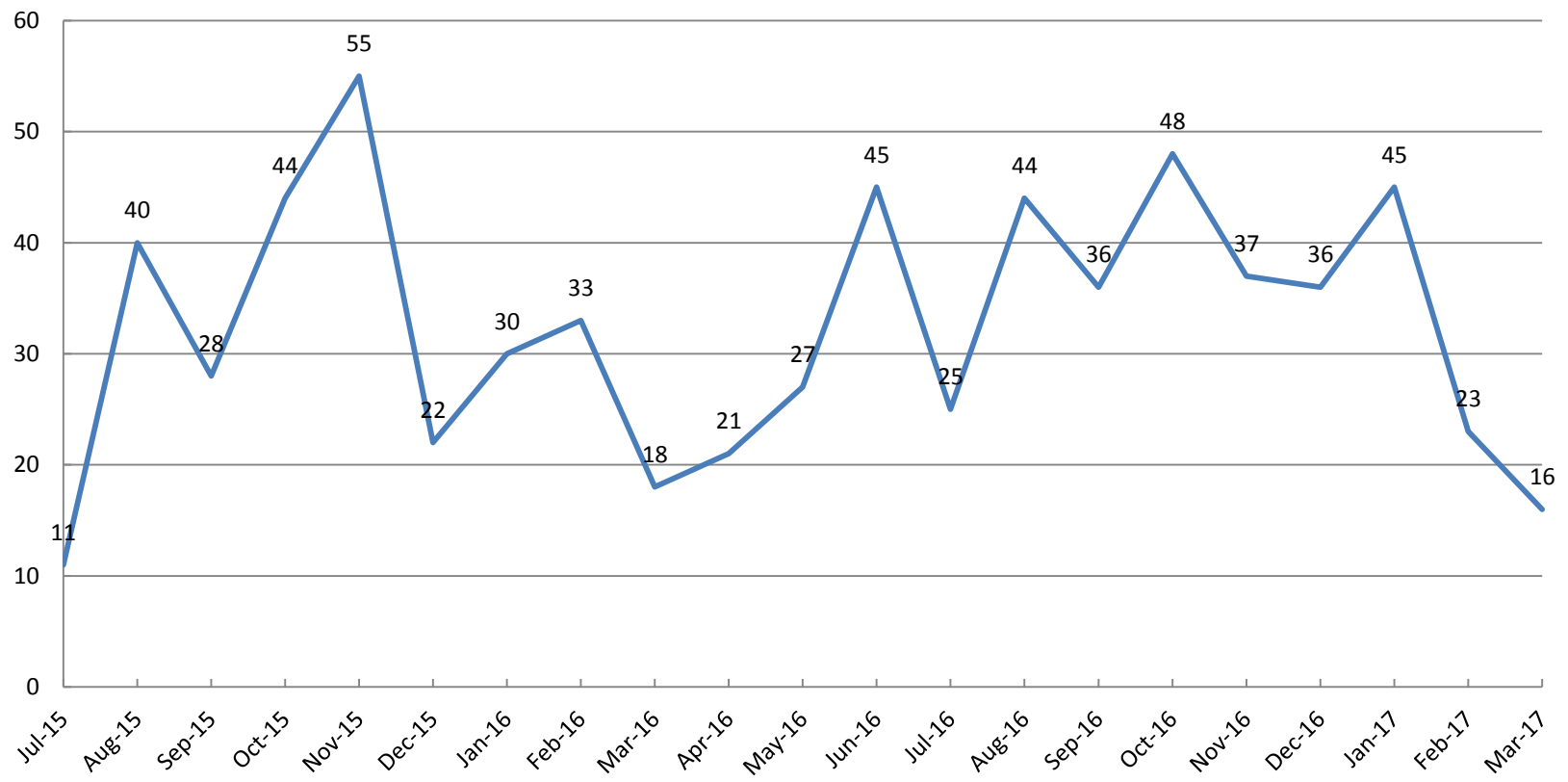

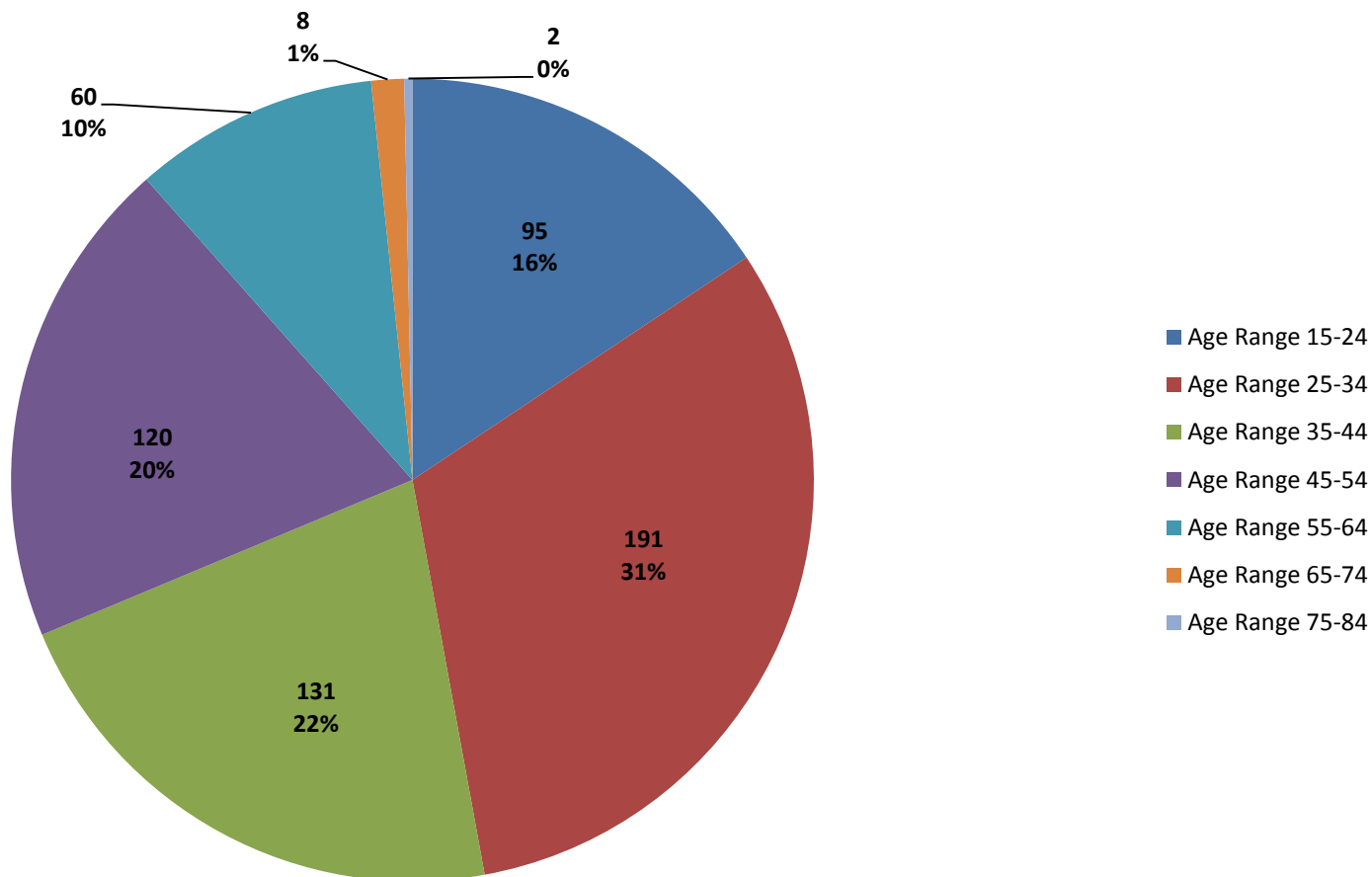

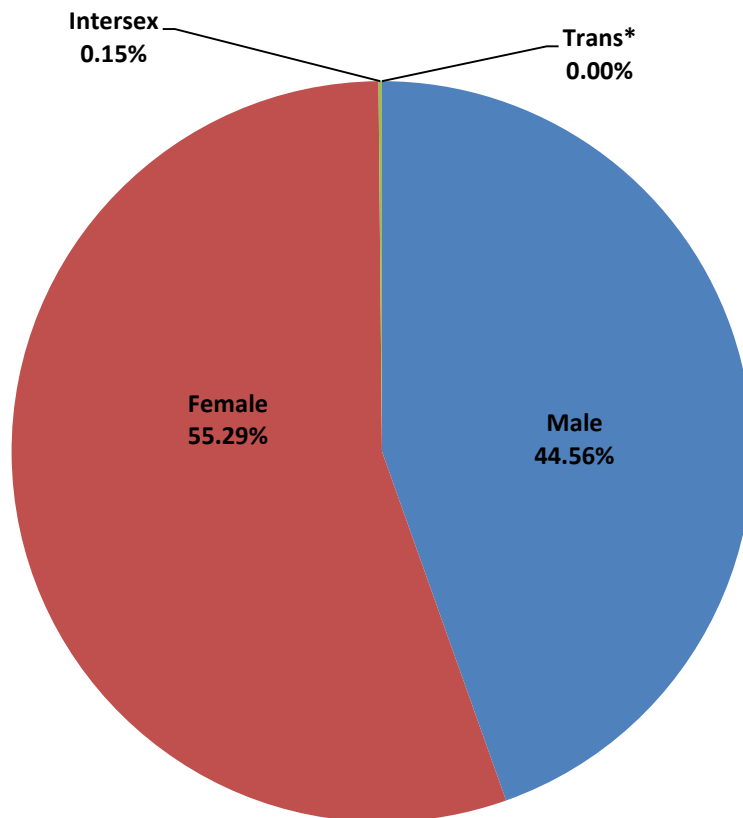
LikeMind SH Referrals In 2015-2017



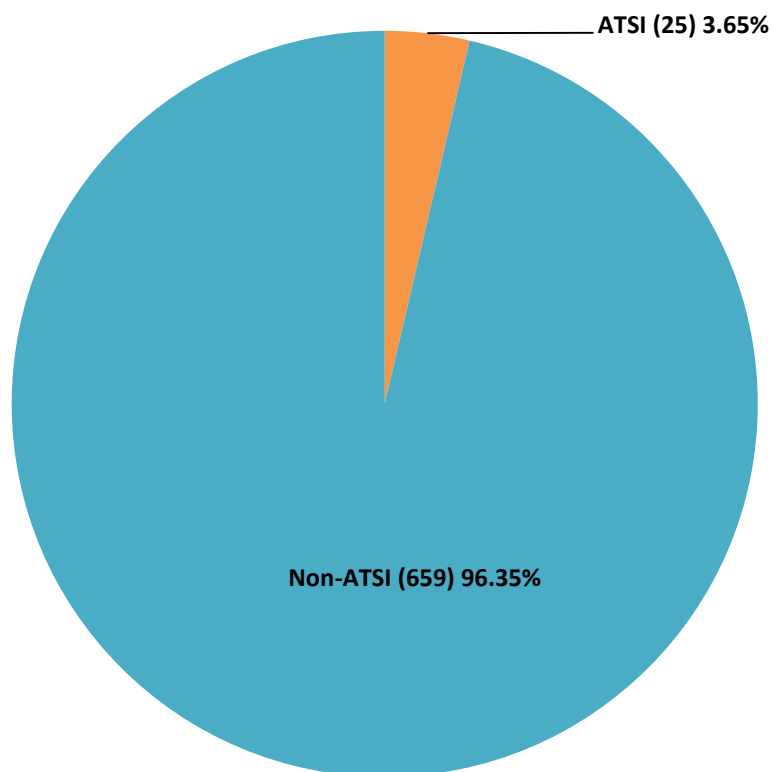
LikeMind SH Age Profile 2015-2017



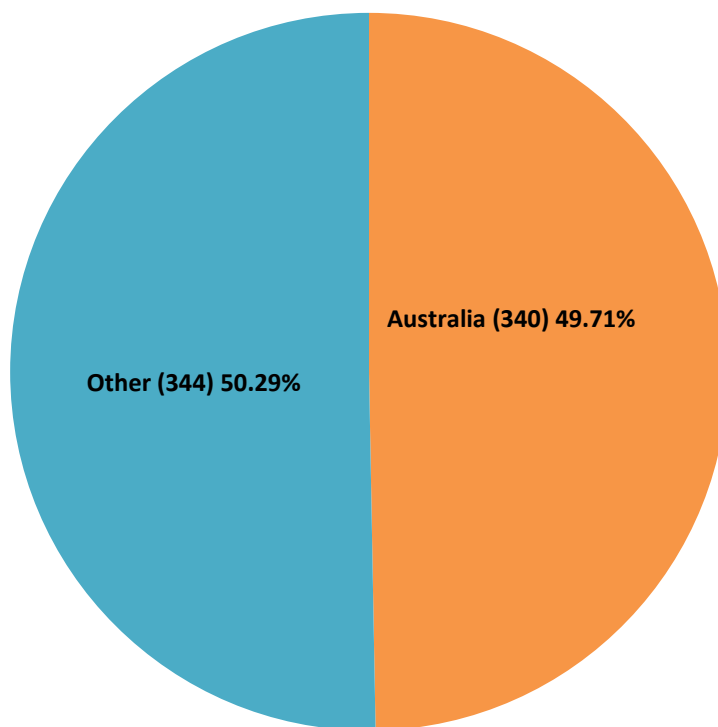
LikeMind SH Gender Profile 2015-2017



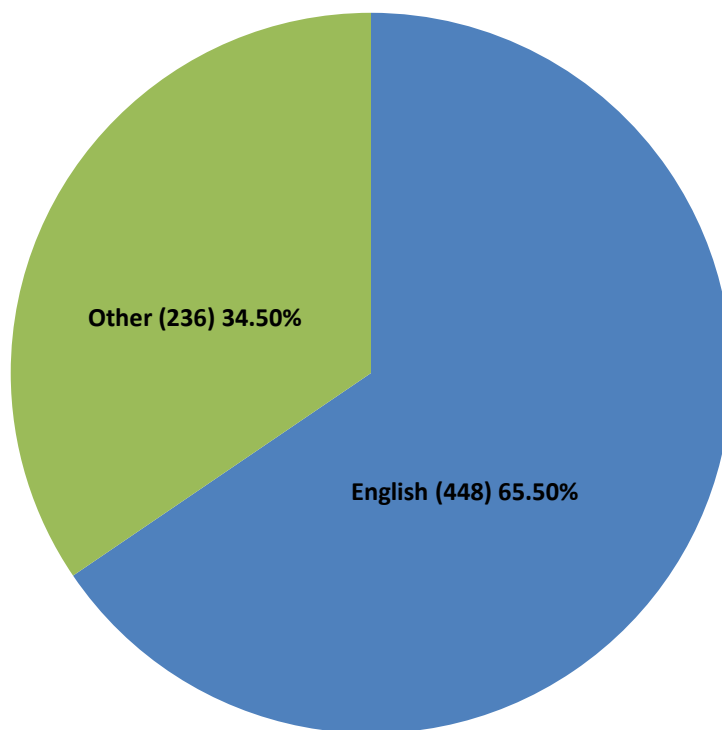

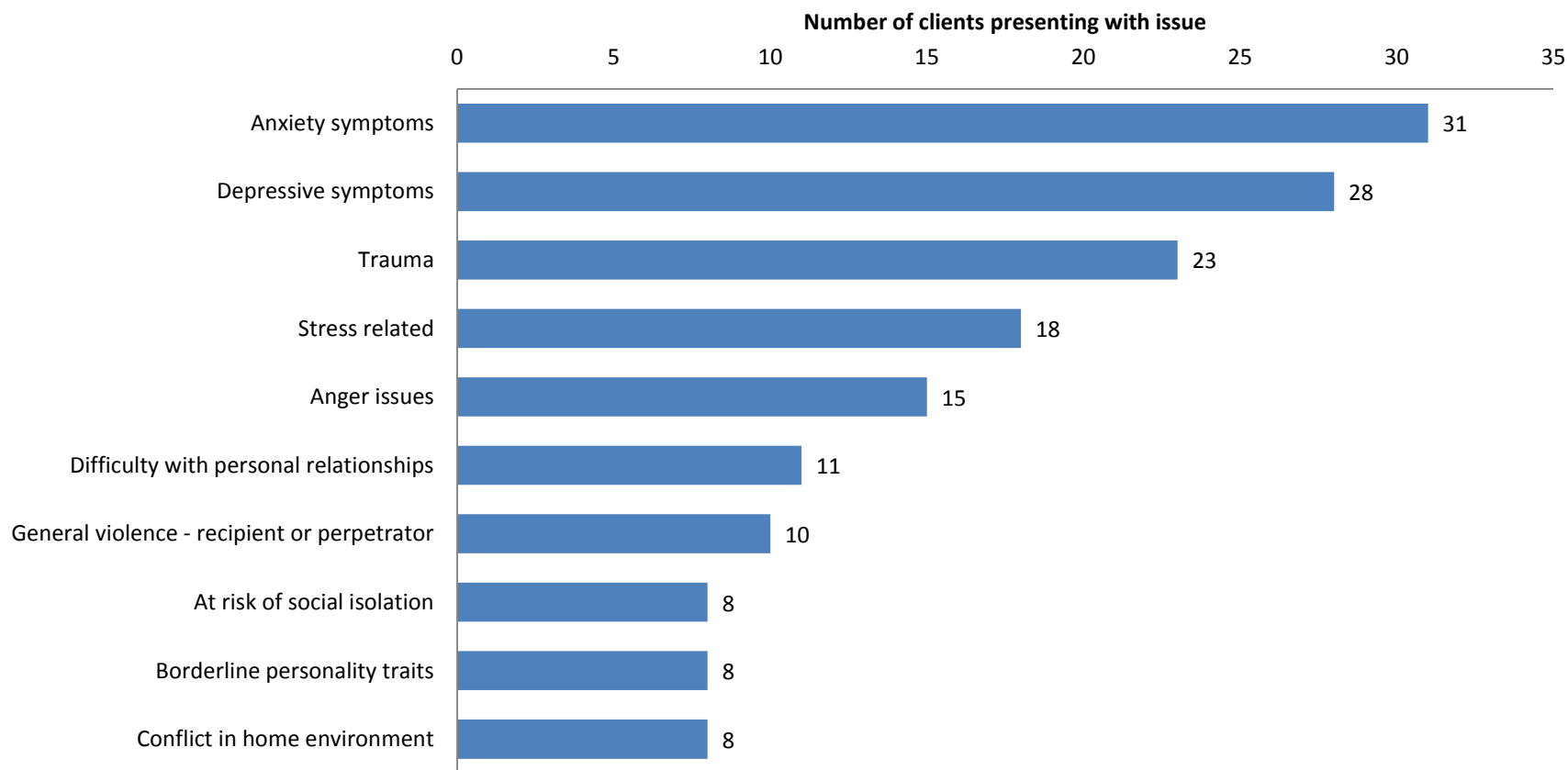
LikeMind SH Country of Birth Profile 2015-2017

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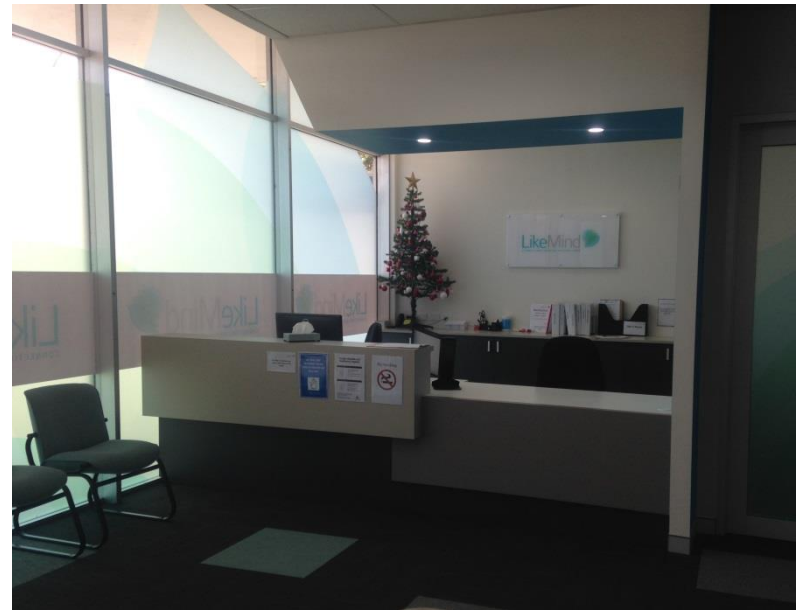
